Items to be purchased at Touchstone (please bring cash or check):

Materials for each student:

- Standard Horseshoe Clay, 25 lbs.....\$5.00
- Pottery Plaster, 25 lbs.....\$3.00
- 1 lb Microcrystalline Wax.....\$9.00
- 1 lb Plasticine Clay.....\$5.00

***Material Fees depend on amount of items purchased and can vary from student to student. The list above can give you an idea of costs for your upcoming class.

Items students should bring with them:

- Tools for their preferred clay shaping methods (throwing, slab building ...)
- At least one metal rib
- 3" scraper/putty knife (I love cabinet scrapers)
- Flexible ribs (mudtools are great, at least one soft and one stiff recommended)
- Surform (again, I like the small mudtools model)
- Small disposable paint brushes
- Rags
- Wet/dry sand paper 100-200 grit (get from auto parts store)
- Coarse drywall sanding screen
- Sponges (one large cleaning sponge, one small clay sponge)
- Leather work or welding gloves
- Safety Glasses
