Suggested Items to Bring for Your Stay at Touchstone:

- The materials, tools, and proper attire/gear as indicated on the materials list specific to your workshop
- Bedding (single/twin-size sheets, blanket(s), sleeping bag, pillow(s), etc.)
- Towels, washcloths, foot/hand towels, toiletries (shampoo, soap, etc.) and hair dryer
- Earplugs (if you are a light sleeper)
- Appropriate clothing for Touchstone's wooded campus comfortable walking shoes, warm clothes for evenings, etc.
- Flashlight for navigating campus in the evenings
- Combination/pad lock for cabin lodging (cabins can be locked from the inside of the cabin, but do not lock on outside; upon settling in to your cabin, make sure your roommate(s) can gain entry with a key or letter/number combination code)
- Laundry detergent, dryer sheets, and quarters (only bring this if you intend to do laundry; washer and dryer for student use are located in the utility room at the rear of the bathhouse)
- Insect repellent, allergy medication, and/or EpiPen for those who have sensitivities to insect stings, pollen, etc.
- Alarm clock, phone charger, camera, laptop computer or tablet (limited wireless connection available at Blaney Lodge; students may not stream YouTube, Pandora, Netflix, Amazon, Hulu or other music/video applications as Touchstone has a limited bandwidth)
- Musical instrument(s), reading material, sketchbook, or portfolio of work to share
- Cash, MasterCard, and/or Visa for materials fees and purchases at the Thursday evening auction or Bea Campbell Gallery Store
- Item(s) to donate to a summer Thursday evening auction (proceeds benefit scholarship funds for deserving students and operations for studio improvements)
