- 1) Small plastic, wood or fabric items that can be molded. Nothing over 6" in any one direction. Examples are small bottles, toys, kitchen items, tools, cups, bolts, screws (**DO NOT BRING GLASS ITEMS**)

Purchase through: Anywhere such items available, found objects, thrift stores, junk drawers

- 2) Wipe Away tools, available on Amazon (Must be at least .25" in diameter for best results. Good example is: 5pcs Red Large-Sized Rubber Tip Paint Shaping Modeling Wipe Out Tools Ceramic Sculpture Polymer Clay Carving Tools

Purchase through: Amazon, or other ceramic suppliers

- 3) Any Tools for Throwing and Handbuilding that you wish to use

Purchase through: Clay King, The Ceramic Shop or local clay store

- 4) Optional: Apron, Towel

- 5) Optional: Banding Wheel if you have one

- 6) Sketch Book, pencils
