- 3) Oil paints or medium of choice (I will be using oils)
Suggested Colors:
 - Titanium white
 - Cadmium Yellow Medium
 - Lemon Yellow
 - Naples Yellow
 - Cadmium Red
 - Alizarin Crimson
 - Ultramarine Blue
 - Cerulean Blue or Cobalt Blue
 - Sap Green
 - Transparent Oxide Red or (Transparent Earth Red)
Optional- Phthalo Green
Violet or Purple
Gamblin Warm White
- 4) Different size brushes

- 5) Canvas, gessoed wood panels, or gessoed heavy paper- 5x7" to 9x12" (If using paper, would need artist tape or clips, and backing board)
