- 4) Dust Masks
- 5) Natural fiber clothing (Avoid Synthetics)
- 6) Close toed Shoes
- 7) Protective eyewear (Touchstone has safety glasses, but feel free to bring your own)
- 8) Bandana/hat (Optional)
- 9) Sketch book
- 10) Earplugs/Hearing Protection
