1) Oil Paint (**Titanium White, Ultramarine Blue, Burnt Sienna**(Gamblin or any professional oil paint))

Purchase through: Blick or Local Art Supplier

2) Completely Odorless Mineral Spirits (either gambling or Sunnyside-completely odorless)

Purchase through: Blick or Local Art Supplier

3) Pallet (Either wood or glass)

4) Brushes, natural or synthetic filberts 2,4,6, and chip brushes half inch and one inch

5) Viva soft paper towels-only

6) Palette knife, single edge razor

7) **Canvas board or Canvas Pads** Lyons makes **16x20**

8) Soft thick Vine charcoal. Blick's soft Charcoal sticks box of 12

9) Kneaded erasers, and a plastic mechanical pencil eraser is also great to have

10) Paper (What you can afford-these are suggestions only but do bring a pad of **newsprint** and a pad of **Strathmore grey toned drawing** paper. The following are nice if you can - **Canson pastel paper pad**. Hahnemuhl-Ingres paper at Blick is a wonderful surface for pastel and charcoal. Of course bring any pastel or good drawing paper.

11) Paint *bring if you have them (Alizarin, Cad Red Med., Cad orange, Yellow orange, cool or light yellow, Cad green (which is a light green) Pthalo Green, Ultramarine and Pthalo Blue, Cerulean, Burnt Sienna, Raw Sienna Titanium White)

12) Prisma color NuPastel, a range similar to an oil painting palette plus white and dark and some grays and ochres
