- 1) Reusable water bottle
- 2) Any of your own blacksmithing tools (tongs, hammers, etc.) No need to purchase anything if you do not already own
- 3) A good hammer to bring if you have one already or want to buy one: 1 ½ or 2 lb cross peen hammer (Peddinghaus 800 gram German Pattern Hammer, for example) (available at Centaur Forge www.centaurforge.com)
- 4) Work Apron (Optional)
- 5) Camera (Optional)
- 6) Natural fiber clothing (Avoid Synthetics)
- 7) Close toed Shoes
- 8) Protective eyewear (Touchstone has safety glasses, but feel free to bring your own)
- 9) Optional: Bandana/hat
- 10) Sketch book
- 11) Earplugs
