



**Dyeing Plant Fibers: A rainbow of techniques on cellulosic fabrics**

- 1) Any personal tools you wish to use (Optional)
- 2) 5-10 Gallon ziplock bags (or 2 gallon)
- 3) 2-3 clean plastic food storage containers with lids, any brand (for ice dyeing)
- 4) 10-15 Pieces of clothing, or fabric, to dye! Must be plant material, so check tags: cotton, linen, hemp, rayon, bamboo, viscose, modal, tencel, etc are a YES. Synthetics (nylon, polyester) are a NO! Upcycle what you already own or thrift for pieces you'd like to dye. They do not all have to start white. Can be light-colored, solids preferred. Heavyweight/stiff fabrics are not ideal for these techniques. Light to mid-weight knits and/or wovens are welcome.
- 5) set of the following: apron, rubber gloves, comfy shoes, note taking supplies, mask if you want one
- 6) Sketchbook
- 7) Safety glasses (optional)
- 8) Pencil and Pen
- 9) Reusable water bottle
